  - 1. CM you are generous <u>givers</u>...*thank you*. I gave a financial update 7 weeks ago about being down 5% from last year. *Your response* as of last week we have completely made up that deficit...*with this week still to go*. PTL.
- E. Prayer: Lord, as we embark on a new year. A new start. And hopefully a new us. We gaze into the future with *hopefulness, spiritual optimism, renewed expectation*. Help us to *dream, and long, and yearn*...for 1 thing...You.

### II. Slide8 Intro: A New Year To Live Out Our Faith

A. Breathe - yes, breathe. Because we only have **one weekend** where we get to **de**celerate from December, and before we **ac**celerate into our new year.

B. Slide9 *Mike Yaconelli*, From Youth Specialties - Every minute we live with Jesus, every week we follow the Master, every year we mark in the company of the Savior gives us a wisdom about life that transcends the <u>expertise</u> of the <u>expert</u>. Experience is more than a great teacher, it is a great *resume* that qualifies all of us to make judgments, decisions, and choices that we can trust and that others can trust. Even our failures can occur with passion and confidence because we know they are the fruit of our <u>previous</u> self, the evidence of our unknowing, the mistakes we <u>need to make</u> in order to know we've made a mistake, & the *necessary preface* to new insights and awarenesses.

## III. Slide10 1) NEW OPPORTUNITIES, NEW OPPOSITIONS (1 Cor.16:7b-9)

- A. 1 Cor.16:7b- I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord permits. 8 But I will stay in Ephesus until Pentecost, 9 for a wide door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.
- B. Slide11 If the Lord permits (7) Paul didn't know everything that was going to happen.
- C. Slide12 A wide door a *door* is a metaphor for *opportunity*. [wide = *megas*]
  - Rev.3:7,8 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens. I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which <u>no one is able to shut</u>.
  - 2. *msg* **A huge door of opportunity** for good work has opened up here. There is also mushrooming opposition.
- D. Slide13 Effective or adapted to success. Producing an intended result.
- E. Slide14 Has opened to me lit. stands wide open.
  - 1. Open infers that some doors are or can be, shut!
    - a) Often we see *imagined prison bars* but in reality they're open doors of opportunity.
  - 2. Alexander Graham Bell said, *When one door <u>closes</u>, another <u>opens</u>, but we often look so long and regretfully at the closed door that we do not see the one that has opened for us.* 
    - a) Are there any doors in front of your face at this time that you are still staring at?
    - b) <u>Is it not</u> a great way to pray to ask the Lord to open or close *doors* regarding His direction for your life? (i.e. *If the Lord permits vs.7*)

- 3. And when you find an open door it doesn't help you unless u walk through it!
  - a) At the Red Sea crossing in Ex.14:15 the LORD said to Moses, Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to *go forward*.
- F. Slide15a There are many adversaries expect them. Don't automatically see *adversaries* as *closed doors*. Don't automatically see *adversaries* as *the Lord being mad at you*.
  - Slide15b A Pessimist is one who sees a difficulty in every opportunity. A Optimist is one who sees an opportunity in every difficulty.
    - a) There is an opportunity in every difficulty and a difficulty and every opportunity.
    - b) That is why so many blessings are missed, so many heights left unscaled, so many fine chapters of service left unwritten. *J.Sidlow Baxter*
  - 2. Believers are not usually left to pursue our work unhindered. It's part of the conditions under which we serve God *that* <u>when</u> we have great opportunities of service we also have *serious difficulties*.
    - a) Ps: overcoming opposition is part of the opportunity.
- **G**. Any doors you're trying to **kick down**? Any doors you've just been **standing in its threshold**? Any *opportunities* you haven't taken because of **fear**?
- H. We have another open door in this new year, 2020.
  - 1. These last couple of days will shut 2019's door. How ever we try to breach it, it is shut never to open again. But the door of the new year, *by the grace of God*, now swings open :)
  - Let's not try to break that old door of 2019 open, *w/useless regrets & shattered dreams*. But instead turn our eyes to the great new door of opportunity which 2020 sets before us.

# IV. Slide16a 2) REMEMBER IT RIGHTLY, 2019

- A. Not just what you **did wrong or** what **went wrong**.
  - What about all of the ways He made? What about all of the promises He kept? What about all of the situations that He carried you through? What about all of the valleys He walked you out of?
- B. Slide16b Did you know on the iPhone, it can make a *Memory* movie (of pics it's stored up)

- 1. Maybe we should do the same in our *minds* (it doesn't grab every picture).
- 2. See I want to *skip some scenes* of 2019. Not that they didn't happen. But I'm just not putting them in my movie.
- C. Slide16c It's my memory, I get to control it.
  - 1. I can focus in on the one thing *she or he* said that hurt me, or the 99 times *she or he* was so kind.
  - 2. Slide16d Manage your memory! Edit your movie.
  - 3. Just as we need *muscle memory* in the gym, so we need *miracle memory* in our mind.
- D. Philip 1:3 Paul said, I think my God every time I remember you.
  - 1. Slide16e Paul learned to remember the outcome, not the opposition.
  - 2. Philip 1:4 adds, *always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with Joy*.
    - a) Slide16f Don't remember the pain, remember the purpose.
    - b) Paul doesn't remember the **prison**, but the **purpose**. And because the **purpose** is so big, so the **nights in prison** seems so small.

# V. Slide17a 3) IS YOUR LIFE STUCK ON PAUSE?

- A. I was watching a *Jason Bourne movie* Thurs night, when right towards the end the DVD got stuck.
  - 1. I've learned **DVD's** can get stuck 3 ways: by me (hitting pause on remote). by someone else (Sully, 1 time). or it just happens (scratch on DVD).
  - 2. Life seems to be the same way: I've made myself <u>stuck</u>. Someone else helped. Life.
    - a) Slide17b Don't get stuck. Don't remain stuck.
- B. Slide17c It's time to turn the page. I want a new story. A new song. A new example of God <u>changing</u> my life. How about a new problem to fight? How about a new area of growth in your faith?
  - 1. We believers should own the market on *change*.

#### VI. Slide18a 4) UNTRIED (untested)

- A. The year ahead 2020 is untried. It is beckoning a tomorrow filled with *new experiences* & *possibilities; risks to take; relationships to build.* 
  - 1. The wise in heart will enter 2020 with faith, hope & scriptural optimism.
  - 2. Determine to take advantage of every God-given opportunity.
  - 3. Resolve to not see church as an institution but a family.
  - 4. Decide to get something out of your devotions & not just do them.
  - 5. Choose an *intimate walk* with Jesus.
- **B**. Slide18b It is comforting to know that the **God** who guides us, sees **tomorrow** more clearly than we see **yesterday**.
- C. Slide19 *Benjamin Franklin* gave the advice, Be always *at war with* your vices, *at peace with* your neighbors, and let each new year find you a better man/woman.

# VII.Slide20a 5) 2020 A NEW YEAR TO LIVE OUT OUR FAITH

- A. 2020 can be...
  - 1. A challenge to live not only a **Personal** & Transforming relationship with **God**, but a **Public** & Transforming relationship with **the world**.
  - 2. A challenge to not just believe, but love your neighbors, & even our enemies.
  - 3. A challenge to go be the Good News.
    - a) James 2:18 But someone will say, You have faith, and I have works. Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith **by my works**.
    - b) Slide20b True Religion is a religion w/feet.
  - 4. A challenge to make your faith public.
  - 5. A challenge to see life as so much more than God & yourself (i.e. the world).
  - 6. Slide20c A challenge to Live in High Definition...or even 4K.
    - a) High Definition is a High Resolution, speaking of the **detail** an image holds.
    - b) Are you living out your spiritual life in: Grainy b/w? Technicolor? HD? or 4K?
    - c) Slide20d Or, how about living it, in 8K?

  - 2. Resolve to Love People Authentically.
  - 3. Resolve to Make **Disciples** Globally.
