PPP (Pain is Part of the Process)

I. Slide1 Announce:

- A. Slide2-5 Larry: Womens min Mtg. Fresh Hope. Missions Class. Better Together/Worship.
- B. Slide6-8 Larry Hani Update:
- II. Slide9 Intro: PPP (Pain is Part of the Process)
 - A. Sometimes we *suffer* because we're **rebelling against God**... Sometimes we *suffer* because we're **obeying God**.
 - B. During Jesus' *farewell address* to His disciples, He was drawing for them a *dark picture* of what was to come. He doesn't **lighten** in any way the *dark picture* He had drawn, but rather *shades it in* more deeply.¹

III. Slide 10 FOREWARNED IS TO BE FOREARMED (1-4)

- A. (1) Jesus is preparing them for rough weather ahead.
- B. (2) Note: They will put you out. Indeed. They will do these things. *Not if but* when their hour comes.
- C. Slide11 Producing Diamonds. The exact mechanism of the production of diamonds is still a matter of debate among geologists, but it is certain that both tremendous heat and tremendous pressure are required for *the crystallization of carbon* into this form.
 - 1. Imagine for a moment communicating w/a diamond in the rough, this hunk of carbon. It's about to be placed into the most intense pressure & put under the most tremendous amount of heat that it will ever experience.
 - 2. It doesn't understand the **beauty** that we understand when we think *Diamond*. As much as you try to <u>convince</u> that hunk of Carbon, or try to <u>warn</u> it of its <u>coming persecution</u>, it will never fully understand till it's right in the midst of it. But you send the warning out, so when its in the midst of it, it can remember back, <u>there is</u> an <u>end</u> to this torment & it is supposed to be <u>Glorious</u>.

- D. I went to a Diamond factory in Israel. We saw how a ruff stone is **cut** many times. Then taken to the **grinding stone**. Then **polished**...before it was *beautiful*. We are in the same process.
 - 1. There must be *friction*, *cutting*, *reshaping*, & *polishing* w/trials/pain/suffering in our lives.
 - a) So what is your *pain* today? Physical, emotional, relational, financial, spiritual?
 - b) Where are you feeling the heat & the pressure in your life?
 - c) Would you say you're in the *cutting*, *reshaping*, or *the polishing* stage?
 - d) Remember, the end...is glorious! Rom.8:18 *Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later.*
- E. Slide12 (2) Don't be surprised when you are persecuted by *religious people*. This has been going on since Cain & Abel (Cain was religious).
- F. When whoever kills you think of the 11 in front of Him he's talking to.
 - Andrew was crucified. Bartholomew was beaten and crucified. James, the lesser, was stoned & clubbed to death. James, the major, beheaded. John was exiled for his face, died of old age. Judas, not Iscariot, stoned to death. Matthew, speared to death. Peter was crucified upside down. Philip & Simon were both crucified. Thomas was speared to death. Matthias was stoned to death. Fox's book of martyrs
- G. Slide13a Every **cut** made on a **diamond** is for a <u>purpose</u>, & <u>chosen</u> with much care...to give it even more *color*, *fire* & *brilliance*.
 - A diamond is considered the most beautiful stone because of its cuts (in raw form it's pretty ugly).
 - 2. One diamond cutter took **2 months** before he picked up his chisel & rapped it w/one blow. (It was on the *Liberator Diamond* largest ever found in Venezuela)
 - a) In honor of Simon Bolívar, liberator of Venezuela, from Spanish government. Discovered in 1942 in *la Gran Sabana Venezuela*; it weighed **155 carats**. It was purchased by Harry Winston in 1943. It was cut in 4 diamonds.
 - 3. Slide13b That same type of care goes into **every blow** that is allowed to come **your way**.
 - Left uncut they are **not brilliant** & will **never sparkle**.

- a) Intense **Pressure**, tremendous **Heat**, special **cuts**, & much **polishing**, is what is needed for it to show its *fire*, *luster*, *color*, & *beauty*.
- b) Would you rather stay a hunk of carbon?
- 4. The world doesn't realize that the worse they could do to us is make us *shine brighter*.

IV. Slide14a GAINES & LOSSES (5-15)

- A. (5) No one is asking Him *NOW*. (yet *Thomas* did in 14:5. And *Peter* did in 13:36,37)
- B. What does Jesus reveal here, as the persecuted believers main line of defense?
 - 1. The power of the Spirit in their lives. (and that's how we can specifically pray)
- C. (6,7) **Sorrow** has filled your heart, *Nevertheless*...here He *shades in* the already dark picture. [as a *good Physician* continues to tell you **all** the bad news about the disease]
 - 1. Slide14b Sometimes the **heart** needs to have **funeral**, so it can **heal up & move on**. Don't shortcut pain or shortchange suffering.
- D. Christian leadership is about sorrow/sacrifice for the well-being of *others*.
 - If you want to be a good husband, sacrifice for the well-being of your wife and children.
 - 2. If you want to be a good **mother**, sacrifice for the well-being of your husband and children.
 - 3. If you want to be a good *business leader, ministry leader, civic/community leader*, sacrifice for the well-being of others.
- E. Slide14c (7) I tell you the truth I always think, Wait, You weren't earlier? :)
 - 1. In conversations, Easterners often **exaggerate** so as to pay compliments to one another. At times what they say is in the form of **a joke**.
 - 2. The word *truth* is thus frequently used in order to carry conviction.
 - 3. I tell you the truth means what I am telling you is **truth**, not a **joke** or an **exaggeration**. It is something that I can sustain.
 - 4. Jesus often spoke in parables and figures of speech. When He would speak of His death, they didn't always take it seriously.

- F. Slide14d Your advantage that I go away (die) as Oscar Hammerstein II said, A bell's not a bell 'til you *ring it*, A song's not a song 'til you *sing it*, Love in your heart wasn't put there to stay, Love isn't love 'til you *give it away*.
- G. Slide15a The Helper, the Spirit of Truth, the Comforter, our Guide, our Counselor, the Spirit of grace, the Spirit of glory, the Eternal Spirit, the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. He is represented as Water, Oil, Wind, Fire, Dove, & a Seal (i.e. a wax seal).
- H. (8-11) He will **convict** the world of sin *He will*, not we will.
 - 1. We tend to want to do the convicting...
 - a) Someone needs to **convict** them I'll do that.
 - b) Someone needs to judge their situation I'll do it.
 - c) Someone needs to show them **righteousness** I'm available :)
 - 2. See, we tend to be bible lovers, but not HS lovers (we need to be both).
 - a) How about letting the Holy Spirit do **His** work?
- I. Slide15b (9) Of sin because they do not believe in Me Sin is *rebellion against God* and this rebellion reached its climax in the crucifixion of Jesus.
 - 1. The world cares about *crime*(wrong between **man** & **man**) but not *sin* (wrong between **man** & <u>God</u>)
 - 2. Sin is no longer merely **transgression of a law**(willful disobedience) but **refusal of a Savior**.
 - a) Today, the greatest sin is the failure to believe in Jesus.
 - b) Most people do not readily admit to being guilty of sin. They will admit to failures or vices or even crimes. However, sin is against God.
 - c) Man can come up with an excuse for committing some *crime*, but has no excuse for rejecting a Savior.
 - d) To reject that dear Savior is the sin of all sins which damns the soul!
- J. (10) Of righteousness because I go to My Father & you see Me no more -
 - 1. Where Jesus leaves off, the Spirit taken on.
 - 2. He comes to authenticate the personal righteousness of Jesus.

- 3. See, in crucifying Jesus, the Jewish people showed that they thought He was unrighteous. Only a <u>wicked</u> person would be hanged on a tree and thus be under God's curse. But the Resurrection and the Ascension vindicated Jesus as God's **righteous** Servant.²
- K. (11) Of judgment because the ruler of this world is judged -
 - 1. Not just *going to be* judged, but *already is* judged.
 - 2. The world's condemnation of God's holy Son to that awful Cross, boomerangs back as the most awful condemnation of the world which did it.
 - a) Sentence is already passed on this world & its prince.
 - b) For the church(the blood-washed & spirit-born) there awaits victory & freedom! For the world, the flesh, & the devil...hopeless defeat, the bottomless pit & the lake of fire.
 - 3. God puts **Christ** on the throne of heaven & sends **the Holy Spirit** to call out a people, to be a special treasure to His dear **Son** even <u>the Church</u>.³
- L. The Holy Spirit will convict/convince men of their *false standards* of sin, righteousness and judgment. *He will show them*...
 - 1. That the essence of sin is unbelief in Christ.
 - 2. That *true righteousness* is not that of *the works of the law* but the righteousness seen in Christ and declared in the Gospel.
 - 3. That judgment awaits all who follow the ruler of this world.
- M. Slide16a (12) I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now same today. We are still not spiritually ready for certain truths. (i.e. what if God told me when I 1st got saved, you will be a pastor, have enormous responsibilities of people's lives, etc)
- N. Slide16b (13) He will **guide** you into all truth *The task* ahead of us is never greater than the **power** behind us.
 - 1. For someone to guide you he must see the way, & lead you there.

- 2. Guide dogs are carefully trained to lead their master through the busiest traffic. And these dogs always seem so calm as they guide. They're not easily excited. They don't wait for a chance to dash across between the cars. Their eyes & ears always attentive. When all is clear, they safely guide their visually impaired master across the busy street. The visually impaired person is safe for he walks by faith in his guide. He trusts his guide.
 - a) I read...Guide dogs are trained to display *intelligent disobedience* they will actually **refuse to obey an unsafe command from their owners** if they see a danger their owners may have missed, such as a car that ran a red light.
- O. (14) He will glorify Me The **Son** came & glorified the **Father**, now the **Spirit** comes & glorifies the **Son**.
 - Science often glorifies knowledge. Philosophy can glorifies reason.
 History often glorifies great men. Society tends to glorifies its movie stars, rock stars & athlete stars, but the Holy Spirit comes to glorify Jesus only.
- P. (15) The Spirit helps us *witness to the world* and *glorify Christ before the world*, so depend on Him.
- Q. Our prayer: O Lord, help us to **calmly trust** the HS, our **faithful Guide**. Teach us to **trust** & to **walk by faith** through *the traffic of our life*. Thank you for the promise, you will **guide** us with your eye. Ps.32:8
