Living Right Side Up in an Upside Down World

 - 1. Voting Thoughts: So which is it? Vote your <u>party</u>. Vote your <u>Conscience</u>. Vote your <u>values</u>. <u>Lesser</u> of two evils? [15 mill christians not registered to vote]
 - 2. We are **discipled** all week long by **pundits** & **memes**. I challenge us as believers that our political engagement would be a matter of <u>public holiness</u>
- E. Problem:(CT) "Almost 90% of Republicans say Democrats are brainwashed and hateful, and the numbers are even higher the other way around. Sadly, these dynamics are paralleled in the church." How about a little more charitable conversations especially w/in the community of faith. How? 2 ways:
 - 1. Love: G.K.Chesterton said, "the Bible tells us to love our <u>neighbors</u>, and also to love our <u>enemies</u>; probably because generally they are the same people." Can you learn to love your political enemy?
 - 2. Principles Before Policies: Focus on the *issues* behind the issues. How do we honor the image of God in every person? What does it mean to *do justice* and *love mercy*? How should the 9th commandment, *you shall not bear false witness*, impact our <u>speech</u>, and the way we interact with our *political sparring partners*, & esp what we post on <u>social media</u>?
- F. *Make sure you're **registered** to vote. ***Vote**! *Remember **Principles** b4 policies. *Let **your** *political engagement* be a matter of **public holiness!**
- G. Slide8 Prayer: Elijah Collins (16, seizure in pool w/family). Jamie/Meghan. *Read txt*.

II. Slide9 Intro: Living Right Side Up in an Upside Down World

- A. Well, I thought I was going to get farther in my message, so I entitled it *Neck Deep in Greece*. But we're not going to make it to Greece. We're still in *Macedonia*.
- B. All of Acts covered a period of 30 years. It focused on 13 cities of the ancient world. Thessalonica is one of the few on the list still a city today, 2000 yrs later.
- C. Slide 10 Map: Released from jail in Philippi, Paul & Silas with sleeves rolled up, minds engaged, hearts ablaze...head to Thessalonica. (100 miles)
 - 1. Enthusiasm, zeal, drive, vision...these are the characteristics of a person who is *fully alive* (someone *living the abundant life*).
 - 2. John Powell describes in his book Fully Human, Fully Alive... "Fully alive people are not necessarily happy all the time. No they experience failure as well as success. They are open to both pain and pleasure. The have many questions and some answers. They cry and they laugh. They dream and they hope. The only thing that remains alien to their experience of life is passivity and apathy. They say a strong yes to life and a resounding amen to love. They feel the strong stings of growing, but their sleeves are always rolled up, their minds are whirring, and their hearts are ablaze."1

III. Slide11 THESSALONICA (1-9) Read

- A. Slide12 They are following *the Egnatian Way* (main highway through Macedonia). It's the I-40 across US.
 - 1. They arrive in Thessalonica, the 2nd largest city in Greece, & still is. 20,000
- B. Slide13 (2) Three pronged approach to sharing your faith:
 - 1. Reasoning To select, distinguish, then to *revolve* in the mind.
 - a) To have *give & take* conversation. (then using OT scriptures)
 - 2. Explaining To explain thoroughly, *opening something widely to make the contents clearly visible.*

- 3. Proving/demonstrating to present evidence, to place alongside. Paul placed *his own illustrations* alongside Scripture to strengthen his argument.
 - a) Result? Jesus is the Christ [suffer/atonement & rise again/proof of victory]
- C. Paul presented the gospel *accurately, clearly, & practically*. Are we able to do the same?
- D.(5) Like magnets, some people are **drawn closer** (4) & others are **repelled** by it.
 - 1. Slide14 Why do some get <u>upset</u> at the gospel? Because it confronts people with their <u>sin</u> and it calls them to <u>surrender</u>.
- E. Wicked men of the rabble/KJV *lewd fellows of the baser sort*/evil men from the marketplace It seems like <u>every</u> big city has these guys.
 - 1. They don't have jobs but just hang around & harass others in the marketplace. They were the *city loafers* & *hoodlums* of the 1st century.
 - 2. They swarm Jason's house where the missionaries had been staying.
- F. Slide15a (6) These men who have turned the world upside down (Lit. *men who have upset the world*)
 - 1. Did they turn the world upside down? Or right side up? The world <u>is</u> <u>already</u> upside down *because of the fall*. So the people in Thessalonica saw them turn it upside down, because they didn't realize it was already **upside down**...thus making it now *right side up*:)
- G. Slide15b So, the charge was true. *Christianity is Revolutionary*.
 - 1. Our world today needs turning upside down, or right side up.
 - 2. This *revolution* must take place in the hearts of individuals.
 - 3. Slide15c,d The way to change the world is to change the individuals in it a) *You can't have a better world w/o better people.
- H. When Christ comes **into** a life He turns it upside down. How?
 - 1. Jesus turns our **beliefs** upside down the things we once thought were <u>false</u>, now we believe to be <u>true</u>.

- 2. Jesus turns our **pleasures** upside down what we <u>used to</u> find pleasurable vs. <u>now</u>.
- 3. Jesus turns our home life upside down different level of home commitment
- 4. Jesus turns our **hopes** upside down from a <u>hopeless life</u> He gives us a hope of heaven and eternal life.
- I. Slide16 So, 1st, the world is wrong side up. 2nd, the world must be turned upside down. 3rd, we are the men and women to set it right.
 - 1. May we be the change.
 - 2. Lets you & I, **flip** our hearts, our valley, our country, our world...1 heart at a time! [but we have to start w/our own hearts being touched **1st**]
- J. Slide17a Men who have upset the world.
 - 1. The world needs to be upset (eg. 2020 snow globe. Covid. 100 West Coast Fires. West Nile Mosquitoes. Hurricanes). But that's not what I'm talking about...
 - 2. 17b To upset the world for Christ, God uses men & women committed to Christ and the Gospel. John Wesley put it this way, "Give me 50 men who love nothing but God and fear nothing but sin, and I'll change the world."
 - 3. 17c To upset the world for Christ, God uses the message of the Gospel.
 - 4. 17d The proper response to the gospel is: 1st to verify its truth, 2nd to believe in Jesus as Savior, 3rd to follow Him as Lord, no matter what the cost.
- K. In the 1950's there was an *American teacher* who prayed for her HS students. She asked God to touch the world through these students. Her name was *Dorothy Clapp*. She gave 1 young now and *the Gospel of John*, who ended up giving his life at a Billy Graham meeting. His name was George Verner, & in 1961 he & 24 other students drew up a Christian Manifesto for *world evangelism*. In part they wrote:

- Literal adherence to the principles laid down by Jesus Christ would, without a doubt, result in worldwide revolution - a revolution motivated by love, a revolution executed by love, and a revolution culminating in love!
- 2. And we are revolutionaries! We are only a small group of Christian young people..., yet we have determined by God's grace to live our lives according to the revolutionary teachings of our Master. Within the sphere of absolute, literal obedience to his commands lies the power that will evangelize the world. Outside this sphere is the nauseating, insipid Christianity of our day.
- 3. We have committed ourselves in reckless abandonment to the claims of Christ on our blood-bought lives. We have no rights! Every petty, personal desire must be subordinated to the supreme task of reaching the world for Christ. We are debtors. We must not allow ourselves to be swept into the soul-binding curse of modern-day materialistic thinking and living. Christians have been "willing" long enough to forsake all the time has come (and is passing) when we must forsake all! Christ must have absolute control of our time and money. We must yield possessions, comforts, food and sleep; we must live on the barest essentials, that his cause might be furthered. The propagation of the faith we hold supreme! Christ is worthy of our all! We must be ready to suffer for him and count it joy, to die for him and count it gain. In the light of the present spiritual warfare, anything less than absolute dedication must be considered insubordination to our Master and mockery of his cause!
- 4. This is our commitment, and we will press forward until every person has heard the gospel. We will soon be in many different countries, engaged in combat with all the forces of darkness. We look beyond the thousands to the millions; beyond the cities to the countries. The world is our goal! And our primary targets are the seemingly impenetrable areas of the Communist and Moslem countries which can only receive freedom as they have opportunity to receive the Truth. These countries will be

reached for Christ no matter what the cost. The ultimate victory is ours! (George Verwer, Come! Live! Die! [Tyndale House], pp. 14-16.)

- L. This was the beginning of *Operation Mobilization* which now has missionaries all over the world, often in the most difficult places to reach for Christ. The young man *George Verner* was *the founder* of **OM**.
 - 1. Even if the Lord does not call us to go to other countries, He does call us all to the same revolutionary commitment to Christ and the gospel.
 - 2. He wants us to *upset our world* for Jesus Christ.
 - 3. May we be believers who live right side up in an upside down world.
