#### The Book That Wouldn't Die

- I. Slide1 Announce:
  - A. Slide2-5 Married Couples. DivCare. Tanzania Trip. Women's Retreat Planning mtg.
- II. Slide6 Intro: The Book That Wouldn't Die
  - A. Ash Wednesday is today its starts 40 days of fasting & the Lent season (excluding Sundays) leading up to Easter. Its name, is from the practice of placing ashes (from Palm branches) on the forehead as a celebration and reminder of *human mortality*, and as a sign of mourning and repentance to God.
    - 1. Similar to sackcloth and ashes in the OT.
    - 2. It's a day to **reflect** on the state of your **heart** and **mind**. A day to *take stock* of your relationship with God, and to accept the grace that He freely offers.
      - a) What do you need to **confess** with this *ash-laden* season of your life?
    - 3. Remember, it starts with ash Wed, but ends with resurrection :)
  - B. Prayer: HS in Florida, 17 deaths:
  - C. *Ask*: I bet you can remember *1 impact scripture* that sent reverberations through your spiritual life. [Rom10.9 *that if you confess w/your mouth...*]
    - The Book That Wouldn't Die.

# III. Slide7 DOING GOD'S WORK (22:1-7)

- A. Josiah a good king. 640-609bc Only he & Hez walked in all the ways of his father David.
  - 1. Jedidah (his mom) beloved (similar to the Lord's pet name for Solomon).
  - 2. Certainly Hilkiah, the high priest, saw to it that the young king honored the Lord.
    - a) Never underestimate the power of godly influence.
  - 3. The young King dedicated his life to the Lord at age 16. He began campaigning against idolatry at age 20 (2 Chron.34:3-7).
  - 4. **Jeremiah** and **Zephaniah** prophesy during his reign. By the time of the events in **this chapter**, Josiah was **age 26**.

B. (7) Trust on a handshake.

## IV. Slide8a DISCOVERING GOD'S WORD (22:8-20)

- **A. THE PRIEST (8-13)**
- B. The Book of the Law is found & it launches a *Revival* throughout Judah.
- C. Some of the phrases suggest that he found some form of **Deuteronomy**.
  - 1. Imagine losing the word of God in the house of God.
  - 2. It it is good to **have** God's Word, it is even better to **hear** God's Word, the greatest blessing of all is to **heed** God's Word. Warren Wiersbe
- D. Slide8b THE PROPHECY (14-20)
- E. Huldah is the only female prophet in the books of 1,2 Sam, 1,2 Kings, & 1,2 Chronicles.
  - 1. Given that the king's advisors consulted Huldah on matters of state, she might have been *an official court prophet*.
  - 2. Earlier in Israel's history, **Deborah** was a prophet. Judges 4
- F. *I am gathering you to your ancestors* **Josiah** is **the only king** to whom the author applies this archaic expression. The phrase appears in the Bible only in reference to the patriarchs, Aaron and Moses.
- **G.** What kicked off this reforming zeal in Josiah?
  - 1. Ps.119:161b my heart stands in awe of Your word.
    - a) Bird Dog Story: A man had a favorite bird dog that was special to him got separated, had to leave remembered a trick an old dog trainer told him, he took his shirt put it under some leaves under a bush came back next day (worried) to find him curled up on it with his nose under the sleeve.
      - (1) When **you** get lost, do you have the **trust** to look for *some part of God's* Word & **curl up in it**? And find once again His Peace like a River.
- H. Slide9 Read Is.66:1,2.

- I. (1,2) Isaiah closes with, displaying our God as being so *Majestic*, no earthly temple could contain Him.
  - 1. Besides, how do you build a house for the Lord *when* He made everything?
    - a) I've seen some of the greatest houses of worship man has devised in which to worship God. *Like*...
      - (1) The National Cathedral in Washington D.C. (stained glass impressive).
      - (2) St. Peters basilica in Rome (the art & statues remarkable).
      - (3) The Jade Buddha Temple in Shanghai (both its sitting & reclining Buddha).
      - (4) Hindu temples in India.
      - (5) The Muslims 3rd & 5th holiest site on the Temple Mnt: the *black* dome Al Aqsa mosque & The *golden* dome of the Rock mosque (They believe this is where Abraham almost sacrificed *Ishmael* not Issac).
  - 2. So, God is so great He uses *the earth* as His ottoman/footstool...Yet, He condescends to fellowship w/those who are <u>humble</u> & <u>heed</u> His word.
- J. Slide10 Who will the Lord look upon? (w/favor) 3-fold:
  - 1. Humble GK Chesterton, *Humility* is the mother of giants. One sees great things from the valley; only small things from the peak. If a man would make his world large, he must be always making himself small. It is impossible without humility to enjoy anything even pride. It is always the secure who are humble. The real great man is the man who makes every man feel great.
    - a) Winston Churchill was once asked, "Doesn't it thrill you to know that every time you make a speech, the hall is packed to overflowing?"
      "It's quite flattering," replied Sir Winston. "But whenever I feel that way, I always remember that if instead of making a political speech I was being hanged, the crowd would be twice as big."
  - 2. Slide11 Contrite spirit deeply repentant.
  - 3. Tremble at God's Word tremble means to *respect* what God says & fear to disobey it.
    - a) Msg But there is something I'm looking for: a person simple and plain, reverently responsive to what I say.

# V. Slide12a RESTORING TRUE WORSHIP (23:1-20)

- A. Josiah's reign occurred during the *decline* of the Assyrian Empire.
  - 1. As Assyria's influence waned, *a power vacuum* formed in the province of **Samaria** (formerly the kingdom of **Israel**), allowing **Judah** to expand its northern border and extend Josiah's religious reforms into this region. Josiah instituted worship of Yahweh *as prescribed in Deuteronomy* which supports the view that the book of the law found by Hilkiah was a version of Deuteronomy.<sup>1</sup>

#### B. Slide12b THE PLEDGE (1-3)

- C. **Manasseh** rebuilt everything that his father (Hez) tore down, but **Josiah** tore down what Manasseh built up.
  - 1. *Reformation alone* will not change people, there must be repentance and renewal within the heart.

#### D. Slide12c THE PURGE (4-20)

- E. Are our lives marked by a similar eagerness to *depart from iniquity* and *to live in covenant with God*?
  - 1. Perhaps our lives and our churches could use a good housecleaning occasionally?
- F. (7) Perverted persons the male shrine prostitutes.
  - 1. The Hebrew word used here, *qedeshim*, literally refers to *sacred, consecrated people* and is often understood to refer to *male prostitutes* set apart for pagan worship.
  - 2. Deut 23:17,18 prohibits the daughters or sons of Israel from becoming a *qedeshah*(f) or *qadesh*(m) and then prohibits bringing the wages of a *zonah* whore into Yahweh's house.

# VI. Slide13a JOSIAH KEEPS THE PASSOVER, GOD KEEPS THE PUNISHMENT (23:21-30) A. THE PASSOVER (21-25)

- B. Josiah presides over *the first centralized celebration of Passover* since before the Israelites conquered the promise land, and he enacts additional reforms.
- C. The observance of Passover reminded the people that they belong to the Lord and must put evil out of their lives.
- D. Slide13b THE PUNISHMENT (26-30)
- E. (27) Remove Judah from My sight exact opposite of Numb.6:24-26 *The Lord make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; The Lord lift up His countenance upon you (turn His face toward you), And give you peace.* [here, He is turning His face *away from* them]

### VII.Slide14a 2 BAD KINGS (23:31-37)

- A. **JEHOAHAZ** (31-34)
- B. Slide14b JEHOIAKIM (35-37)
- C. 2 ways to respond to the hearing of God's word:
  - 1. As Josiah heard the Word of God...he tore his clothes (heart/tender, humble, wept). As Jehoiakim heard the Word of God...he tore the Word of God up.
  - 2. See Jeremiah 36:20-32
  - 3. Here we have the book that wouldn't die.
    - a) In music we have a tuning fork known as **A-440** (440 vibrations per sec). It always has been & always will be [5000 yrs. from now it will still be the same pitch it will not change] Same with the Word of God.
  - 4. The Lord handles this w/simply telling Jeremiah to write another scroll (36:28). But this time *he adds the kings doom.* 
    - a) What he could not reach w/knife & fire was of course...their Author.
    - b) Ps.119:89 Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.
    - c) Is.40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever.
  - 5. Slide15 Last quote to Warren Wiersbe, Any king who thinks he can silence God w/a knife & fire, has a very high opinion of himself, & a very low opinion of God.
