Isaiah 32 12-16-04

"The King, His Spirit, & His Kingdom!"

1. Intro:

1.1. Here is Isaiah's 4th promise of a coming king.

2. The King, His Spirit, & His Kingdom! (1-12)

- 2.1. **The King!** (1-4)
- 2.2. (1) What you need is a **King** in your life, the Lord himself who will rule in righteousness and justice.
 - 2.2.1. A King is the Big Boss!
- 2.3. (2-4) What a difference it makes if <u>you</u> have a **King** in <u>your</u> life!
 - 2.3.1. The Lord himself will be to you like a "hiding place from the wind, a shelter in a storm, like refreshing streams of water in a dry place, a cool shade in a hot desert."
 - 2.3.1.1. Sometimes we need to get out of the glare & heat of life & slip into the restful shade of His presence!
 2.3.1.1.1.Ps.91:1 "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the
 - Almighty."

 2.3.1.2. The **Dove** hiding in **the cleft of the rock** finds its safety
 - there despite its worthiness! (It has nothing to do w/that huh?)
 2.3.1.2.1.Believer, you are safe in *The Great Rock of Refuge* & you are safe there *forever*!
 - 2.3.1.3. Q: Which of these do **you** reflect best in your life?
 - 2.3.1.4. Q: Do your friends feel safe in you as a **hiding place** w/their issues or problems?
 - 2.3.1.5. Q: Are you known as a **shelter** during their storms, or do you whip up more wind?
 - 2.3.1.6. **Q**: How can you **refresh them** like a cool stream?
 - 2.3.1.7. Q: Do you **provide shade** during their "Hot" times, or do you help to turn up the heat even hotter?
 - 2.3.1.8. Q: How can you become a **shelter** or **refuge** in your community?
 - 2.3.1.9. "This beautifully describes the **refreshment of spirit** that comes to those who, while walking in the midst of life and not trying to run away from it, **feed their inner life** with the strength and beauty of the Lord their God."
 - 2.3.2. How wonderfully this describes the **escape** from the danger of a "**misplaced confidence**" (i.e. last chapter/Egypt).

- 2.4. **Moral Character!** (5-8)
- 2.5. (5-7) In a leader there should be no conflict between **public duty** & **private morality**.
 - 2.5.1. Also, we should pray for our society not to be **led by fools!** 2.5.1.1. Read Paul Harvey's editorial
- 2.6. God is looking for those whose eyes, ears, hearts, are open to sp. truth.
- 2.7. Generous/Noble = possessing excellent moral character.
- 2.8. **Complacency!** (9-14)
- 2.9. Here's our text for our next men's retreat!
- 2.10. (9-11) Isaiah had a special burden for the **careless women** of the land.
 - 2.10.1. Why? Women(wives, mothers, grandmothers) can have a great influence for **good** or for **evil**.
 - 2.10.2. They were living at ease...as God's gavel was about to fall. 2.10.2.1. They only had a year left (10) before Assyria strikes[701bc].
 - 2.10.3. God's rule will demand an end to complacency!2.10.3.1. When you're complacent you are at ease, or resting on false hopes.
 - 2.10.4. Instead of complacency, they should have **repented** by putting on **sackcloth!**
- 2.11. (13) Their happy homes were about to be destroyed...but they didn't seem to care.
- 2.12. The Spirit's Outpouring! (15)
- 2.13. He describes the future kingdom that started with Pentecost.
- 2.14. Q: Is He poured upon you? How do you know if He is? Are you filled w/Him? How do you know if you are?(Is he a liquid?) What does it feel like? What actually happens?
 - 2.14.1. The Bible never defines it really. It just points out people who were.¹
 - 2.14.2. [1] John the Baptist "For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be **filled** with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb."
 - 2.14.3. [2] Stephen "But he, **being full** of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,"

- 2.14.4. [3] Zechariah "Now his father Zacharias was **filled** with the Holy Spirit, and prophesied, saying:..."
- 2.14.5. [4] Bezalel "See, I have called by name Bezalel...And I have **filled** him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, "to design artistic works,..."
- 2.15. When we are "*Filled Full*" of the H.S. it encompasses 3 things: a completeness, a satisfaction, & a mystery.
- 2.16. [1] A Completeness!
 - 2.16.1. My gas tank is full of gas; He is full of whiskey; She was filled w/fear; Judas was full of the devil; The book of Philip.'s is full of joy.
 - 2.16.2. We are full of the H.S., as Judas was full of the *un-holy spirit/*Devil. 2.16.2.1. The main idea was that he was under the devil's control!
 - 2.16.3. It isn't physical then like a tank of gas.
 - 2.16.4. We're talking about a **relationship** between 2 persons. A relationship where one might let the other dominate!
 - 2.16.5. Eph.5:18 "And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,"
 - 2.16.5.1. When someone is *under the influence* they don't have to tell you they're drunk.
 - 2.16.5.2. They are full of alcohol. You can tell by their **talk**. There **walk** proves it!
 - 2.16.5.3. Isn't that parallel to being filled w/the H.S. Are you under the influence of the H.S.? Is it evident?
 - 2.16.6. A Christian can answer "Am I filled w/the H.S.?", with "yes I have yielded to the will of God, & given him full control."

2.17. [2] A Satisfaction!

- 2.17.1. Another definition for **full** is when we say a child is **full of mischief**. 2.17.1.1. This is highly visible.
 - 2.17.1.2.Most references of "filling" indicate some evidence or outcome of the filling. (people recognized the Spirit at work)
 2.17.1.2.1.The disciples preached w/power; they sang even while in prison; they met each crisis w/faith.
- 2.17.2. You never hear of someone in Scripture claiming to be Spirit-filled! 2.17.2.1. It was always someone noticing or seeing it.
- 2.17.3. Being full of the Holy Spirit shows itself in the outward evidence of "producing fruit in our lives."2.17.3.1.Oh, that we would produce a Bumper Crop of Jesus Fruit!

- 2.17.3.2.A peach hanging off a tree points to what is inside...it is a peach tree! [thus, **Jesus plants** produce **Jesus fruit**!]
- 2.17.3.3. Those around us become **fruit inspectors**: they can tell what's on the inside, by what comes out!
- 2.17.3.4. "Therefore by their fruits you will know them." Mt.7:20.
- 2.17.3.5. Hopefully you're not happy with just a couple little shriveled pieces of fruit dangling from your life.
 - 2.17.3.5.1.Go for Bumper Crop of Jesus Fruit! "fruit, more fruit, much fruit!"
- 2.17.3.6. Example: Pastor Kim attended the trial of a young man accused of killing his 2 sons in a communist insurrection. He asked the judge to pardon the murderer & turn the young man over to him to train to take the place of his sons in serving God. Only the spirit of God can produce that kind of "fruit"
- 2.17.4. Q: Are we "Holy Spirit Effective" in our ministry/service to God? (i.e. things happening that can't be explained w/our natural abilities)
 2.17.4.1. You **teach** & someone yields there life to Christ.
 - 2.17.4.2. You **Show hospitality** & someone is dawn to the church through their gracious hospitality.
 - 2.17.4.3. **Evangelizing &** someone gets saved.
 - 2.17.4.4. **Counseling** someone experiences healing & starts to become more like Jesus.
 - 2.17.4.5. **Helping the poor** and through it someone is drawn toward Christ through your assistance.
 - 2.17.4.6. **Encouraging** someone begins to draw strength from God.
- 2.17.5. I picture a large schooner(a fast sailing ship) sails full of wind... when suddenly a gust of wind sweeps down & it surges the schooner forward under a really full sail!
 - 2.17.5.1.So it is w/the Holy Spirit! {An overdrive surge of power}
 2.17.5.1.1.Ex: A thought comes to mind how to do something right after you've prayed!
- 2.17.6. If the Holy Spirit isn't in our ministry...nothing of eternal value will happen!
- 2.17.7. A Christian can answer "Am I filled w/the H.S.?", with "You tell me! Do you see anything?"
- 2.18. **[3] A Mystery!**
 - 2.18.1. This part defies analysis. It has to do w/inner feelings. Or, "an ecstatic inner sense of God's presence!"
 - 2.18.2. Acts 13:52 "And the disciples were **filled** with **joy** and with the **Holy Spirit**."

- 2.18.3. It's like marriage...is their outward evidence? Yes, children! But there's also a mystery about feelings.
 - 2.18.3.1. Moments of **shared ecstasy**, but also **shared agony**.
 - 2.18.3.2. **Jesus** had joy, & agony!
 - 2.18.3.3. So w/us & the Spirit.
 - 2.18.3.4. Q: Have you had a recent surge of affection, or emotional response, to God's presence lately? (ask for it!)
 - 2.18.3.5. The "inner sense of fullness" is not a constant but a periodic gift! (some mystics through the ages might have experienced more than you or I...but it isn't the norm...but don't you desire more? Tell him!)
- 2.18.4. A Christian can answer "Am I filled w/the H.S.?", with "Sometimes!"
- 2.19. Be being filled w/the H.S.
 - 2.19.1. Is a command to us something **I must do**.

 But it is also in the passive form, something **the Spirit does** to me.
 - 2.19.2. Q: How do these go together? I take the initiative & deliberately yield control! Then I keep praying & expecting Him to produce the fruit of godliness!
 - 2.19.2.1. Keep in an abiding relationship! Be in a steady-state of filling! Stay tight with Him!
- 2.20. **Peace & Quiet!** (16-20)
- 2.21. In Heb.7 Melchizedek, a type of Christ, was known as "king of righteousness," and then also king of Salem, meaning "king of peace,"
 - 2.21.1. There can be no **lasting peace** w/o **righteousness!**
 - 2.21.2. There can be **no short-cut** to **genuine peace!**
- 2.22. Peace Lk.2:14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!" (all men?)
 - 2.22.1. Lk.2:14 NIV "and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests."
 - 2.22.2. True Peace & Biblical Rest do not belong to the <u>unregenerate</u>...it is a peculiar possession of the Lord's people only.
 - 2.22.3. During the **flood** the **chosen family** were quietly secured in the resting-place of the ark. (Jesus the ark of our salvation)
 - 2.22.4. **Israel** rested safely w/the sprinkled blood on their doorframes, while the death-angel flew bye.
 - 2.22.5. Today we rest in the promises of our faithful Father!
 - 2.22.6. We are not to be hiding in our own man made shelters:
 2.22.6.1. Like **David** hiding in the cave of Adullam.
 2.22.6.2. Nor like **Jonah** trying to find shade beneath is gourd!
 2.22.6.3. For no one can **invade** or **destroy** our shelter in Jesus!
