1. Intro:

- 1.1. Ever have a dream that seemed so real, it was frightening?
- 1.2. Interesting, one king has a dream & insomnia...1000's benefit from it.
- 1.3. Historical Background:
 - 1.3.1. Read Babylon Background, Merrill Unger (pg.18)
 - 1.3.2. In all of Neb.'s pride God chooses to speak to him, not dramatically with thunder & lightening, but in the dark in a dream!
 - 1.3.3. "A sleeping King meets the King who doesn't sleep!"
- 1.4. Tonight we are going to look at Scene 1 & 2.
 - 1.4.1. **Scene I = Neb enters The Secret Dream.**
 - 1.4.2. Scene II = Daniel enters The Secret Revealed.

2. Scene I, Neb Enters - THE SECRET DREAM! (1-13)

- 2.1. The Distressing Dream! (1,3)
 - 2.1.1. Q: Why was it so important that Neb understand this dream?
 - 2.1.1.1. The archives of Babylon contained **many books** on dream interpretation.
 - 2.1.1.2. It was popularly believed that dreams were an **avenue** through which the gods spoke to human beings.
- 2.2. Dream(s) Singular in (1), & plural in (3).
 - 2.2.1. Apparently the king was dreaming the same dream.
 - 2.2.2. It was more like a "nightmare" (31) {awesome = terrible}
 - 2.2.2.1. "Great Image" This figure was gigantic.
 - 2.2.2.1.1."A huge statue in human form". Keil & Delitzsch
- 2.3. The Desperate Search! (2,4)
 - 2.3.1. (2) A desperate search went out for the meaning!
 - 2.3.1.1. I'm sure many were wanting to use this opportunity to promote themselves before the king!

2.3.2. 4 classes mentioned:

- 2.3.3. Magicians Sacred scribes, highly educated, & very elite.
 - 2.3.3.1. They taught that they knew things no one else knew.
 - 2.3.3.2. They were trained in the sacred writings & in literature.
- 2.3.4. Astrologers "Whisper's of secret incantations or mysteries".
 - 2.3.4.1. Whisper's, because they practiced their incantations by movements of the breath.
 - 2.3.4.2. Not stargazers as we might think.
 - 2.3.4.3. They later became writers for the "Enquirerer"! ☺ Which their predictions have a 2% success rate, for your info. Yet, "Enquiring minds still want to know" & they pay for it each week by the millions.
- 2.3.5. Sorcerers Witch Doctors.
- 2.3.6. Chaldeans Priests who ran things.
 - 2.3.6.1. There is one more class mentioned in vs.27...the "soothsayers" (gezar)
 - 2.3.6.2. "They determined the fate of men from the position & the movement of the stars at the time of their birth."²
- 2.3.7. (4a) From 2:4b-7:28 is in **Aramaic**.
- 2.3.8. (4b) Feeling pretty confident in numbers, they felt they'd figure this one out..."just give us the dream, & we can definitely make up an interpretation!"
- 2.4. The Deadly Decision! (5,6)
 - 2.4.1. No tricky deals!
 - 2.4.2. It's very easy, "the Dream It's Interpretation Or else!"
- 2.5. The Demand For Delay! (7-9)
 - 2.5.1. When all else fails...stall!
 - 2.5.2. The king wasn't fooled! He must have been suspicious of these guys.
- 2.6. Their Dearth of Deficiency! (10,11)
 - 2.6.1. Backs against the wall \rightarrow They admit their inadequacy.
 - 2.6.2. Astrologers today, psychic hotlines, & fortunetellers, can try to replace God, appear to possess the power of God, pretend to read the future, but they **cannot do** what only God can do!
 - 2.6.3. "Sovereignty & Sorcery are as far apart as heaven & Hell!" (Swindoll)

- 2.7. The Decree to Destroy! (12,13)
 - 2.7.1. Angered by their ignorance & deceptions, Neb sentences them all to death! All the "wise men" of Babylon!

3. Scene II, Dan Enters-THE SECRET REVEALED! (14-23)

- 3.1. **PROBLEM!** (14-16)
- 3.2. Watch how to react in a personal crisis!
 - 3.2.1. The kings captain (Arioch) arrives to execute Daniel.
 - 3.2.2. Wow, what would you do here? {Run, panic, make something up?}
 - 3.2.3. "Some Christians think the only sensible response to unjust secular authority is brash rebellion!"³
 - 3.2.3.1. Not Daniel He had the **Courage** to probe & the **Confidence** in God!
 - 3.2.4. Here Neb's head "hit-man" comes before the king w/one of the guys on "the hit list"?
 - 3.2.4.1. More amazing Neb **listens!** And then Neb gives Daniel **time!** 3.2.4.1.1.ls this proof of God being in control or what?
 - 3.2.4.2. Here Daniel isn't "**stalling**" as they tried, but "**waiting on the Lord**" to see what God might do.
 - 3.2.4.3. A hopeless situation?...No, the perfect opportunity for God to work on behalf of these who trust in HIM!
 - 3.2.4.4. When you don't know, or haven't the answer, and the situation seems hopeless...Find only Him as **sufficient!**
 - 3.2.4.5. **Ps.27:14** "Wait on the LORD; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the LORD!"

3.2.5. Let your **Problems** move to **Prayer!**

- 3.2.5.1. Often we are moved to **whine**, moved to **anxiety**, moved to **complain** to others, or moved to **depression**.
- 3.2.5.2. **Ps. 16:8** "I have set the LORD always before me; Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved."
- 3.2.5.3. If we are going to be moved in a direction we should be **moved to Pray!**

3.3. **PRAYER!** (17,18)

- 3.3.1. Partnership! (17,18)
- 3.3.2. He enlisted others to pray with him for God's help.
- 3.3.3. Prayer! (18a)
- 3.3.4. It is proper for **Problems** to bring about **Prayer**, as long as that's not the "**only**" time we pray!
 - 3.3.4.1. "And Satan trembles when he sees The weakest saint upon his knees."4
- 3.3.5. Daniel didn't say, "Here's the answer"...then wait & <u>hope</u> God would speak to him.
 - 3.3.5.1. He went home to pray. They didn't expect a miracle each time there was a crisis! (see 3:18)
 - 3.3.5.2. They would be faithful to their death.
- 3.3.6. Plea! (18b)
- 3.3.7. Not only to **not** die with them, but later (24) he pleads for them also.
- 3.3.8. Let Answered Prayer move you to Praise!
 - 3.3.8.1. Instead of rushing to the king, or boasting of his new wisdom, Daniel paused to praise the Lord. (paused to praise)
- 3.4. **PRAISE!** (19-23)
- 3.5. This is sometimes called "Daniel's Psalm". Listen for Gods character that is emphasized here.
 - 3.5.1. The Secret Revealed! (19a)
 - 3.5.2. God gave him the interpretation.
 - 3.5.3. "the God of heaven" as opposed to all their gods of the earth.3.5.3.1. He sits on His throne, in heaven, ruling the affairs of men, on earth.
 - 3.5.4. His Omnipotence! (20)
 - 3.5.5. Wisdom & Might belong to Him!
 - 3.5.6. His Providence! (21)
 - 3.5.7. The message...God is in control.
 - 3.5.8. God wasn't worried about their Captivity, nor Neb's threats, nor the circumstances that surrounded them. God wasn't worried!
 - 3.5.9. It never "throws God" if we say **no** to something. He already knew we would, & has planned for it!

- 3.5.10. His Omniscience! (22)
- 3.5.11. There is nothing hidden from God!
- 3.5.12.**Heb.4:13** "And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."
- 3.5.13.His Revelation! (23)
- 3.5.14. He started with "wisdom is Yours"(20) ended w/"& You make it known to me"(23).
- 3.5.15. Notice how your knowledge of God's character changes your perspective on Daniel's situation?
 - 3.5.15.1. Q: How does it change your perspective on **your** "problems"?
- 3.6. Daniel's **Problem** moved him to **Prayer**, Answered **Prayer** moved him to **Praise**, & **Praise** lead him to **Proceed!**
 - 3.6.1. Next week Daniel Proceeds to tell the Dreams Interpretation!
- 3.7. This was undoubtedly the secret of his personal piety and his public achievements.
 - 3.7.1. All Problems to Prayer, which lead to Praise, before He Proceeds!
