1. Intro:

1.1.

2. 5 Woes! (ch.2:5-20)

- 5 woes! Babylon would be used by God to spank Judah…but they also would be spanked for how they did it.
- 2.2. **Ambition!** (6-8)
 - 2.2.1. Ambition can be a **good thing**, **but** when it motivates you to be greedy, selfish, & abusive...it is a very **bad thing**.
 - 2.2.2. The Babylonians were consumed by selfish ambition. They stopped at nothing to acquire wealth & expand their kingdom.
 - 2.2.3. The Medes & Persians ended up fulfilling this prophecy(7,8).
- 2.3. Covetousness! (9-11)
 - 2.3.1. Security...but it was a false security!2.3.1.1. Q: How high do you have to build walls to keep God out?
- 2.4. Exploiting People! (12-14)
 - 2.4.1. Built by slave labor, prisoners of war, etc.
 - 2.4.2. This was only fueling Gods fire against them.
 - 2.4.3. (14) Contrast Babylon's shame & infamy to Gods glory!
 - 2.4.3.1. And there relatively short "glory" compared to God's eternal glory!
- 2.5. **Drunkenness!** (15-17)
 - 2.5.1. Can interpret individual & national.
- 2.6. **Idolatry!** (18-20)
 - 2.6.1. Of what value is a god made by a man?
 - 2.6.1.1. Idols are a dead substitute for the living God!

- 2.6.2. Q: What are you **devoted to** other then God? What do you **delight** in other then God? What couldn't you **bear to be w/o**?
- 2.6.3. Keep silence "Having learned to make the joyful noise, let us also practice the blessed quiet!" (Paul Anderson in Leadership, Vol. 7, no. 2.)

3. A Prayer Hymn! (ch.3:1-19)

- 3.1. A Prayer Hymn! (1-2)
 - 3.1.1. A prayer(1a); a hymn for 3 reasons!
 - 3.1.1.1. [1] Shigionoth (?) a musical term or notation.
 - 3.1.1.2. [2] Selah 3 times, pause.
 - 3.1.1.3. [3] Subscription (see 3:19b)
- 3.2. When your **mind** is wandering; the **situations** is crumbling; your **head** is spinning;...keep your **heart** trusting!
 - 3.2.1. **(1)** Though this is not a **manual** on prayer we can learn a lot from Habakkuk on **how to pray**!
 - 3.2.1.1. [1] Like having a healthy perspective on who God is.
 - 3.2.1.2. [2] Remembering back on how God has worked in history(i.e. know the Word)
 - 3.2.1.3. [3] This takes self-centeredness out of prayer.
 - 3.2.1.4. [4] The better we know Him the better we'll want what He wants.
 - 3.2.1.5. [5] "When God is our focus, our struggles become, not isolated islands of pain, but paths toward Him!" (Swindoll)
 - 3.2.2. Wiersbe defined prayer as, "reminding God of His promises & claiming them for ourselves."
 - 3.2.3. (2) Habakkuk asked "why aren't you working God"? God responded "I am". Now Habakkuk responds "ok your working…please be merciful to your sinful people"!
- 3.3. The Greatness of God! (3-15)
 - 3.3.1. Oh we need a return to <u>this kind of worship</u>...that focuses on His **Glory** & **Greatness**!
 - 3.3.2. In this he seems to be tracing the foot steps from **Sinai** to the **promise land**.

- 3.4. **Hymn!** (16-19)
- 3.5. Here is one of the greatest confessions of faith.
 - 3.5.1. Though Babylon comes to destroy; though You send away your people; though the bottom drops out of everything...yet I will trust in you!!!
 - 3.5.2. Had he **looked ahead** he would only see the invading Babylonian army; Had he **looked within** he would only see fear & trembling; If he **looked around** he would only see everything falling apart; But by **looking up** by faith he saw God...& all his fears vanished.
 - 3.5.3. To walk by faith means to focus on the greatness & glory of God!
 - 3.5.4. "I'm only in the kindergarten of suffering," W.E.Sangster
 - 3.5.5. That I might rest... (NIV) "Yet I will wait patiently for..."
 - 3.5.5.1. 3 verses to help you wait patiently on **Him** to work!
 - 3.5.5.2. [1] Stand Still (Ex.14:13)
 - 3.5.5.3. [2] Sit Still (Ruth 3:18)
 - 3.5.5.4. [3] Be Still (Ps.46:10)
 - 3.5.5.5. When things are stirred up within you...stop, pray, wait... before we do something stupid!
 - 3.5.6. (17) By the time Babylon was done w/Judah there wouldn't be much of value left.
 - 3.5.6.1. Even when we cannot rejoice in the **economy**, we can rejoice in the **Lord**!
 - 3.5.6.2. Seems like little to sing about yet...!
 - 3.5.7. (18) But God was still on the throne!
 - 3.5.7.1. This is no "whistle in the dark" to build up our courage.
 3.5.7.1.1.Ever do that when you're scared?
 - 3.5.7.2. No this is singing about the Eternal God who Never Fails!
 - 3.5.7.3. Faith always lifts us higher & makes us happier! (see 18 &19)
 - 3.5.7.4. Habakkuk couldn't rejoice in the **circumstances**, but he could rejoice in his **God**!
 - 3.5.7.4.1. How else could we really "Glory in our tribulations?"

- 3.5.7.5. 1 Thes. 5:16-18(NIV) "Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."
- 3.5.7.6. Q: Can you worship Him no matter <u>how</u> you **feel** or <u>what</u> you **see**?
- 3.5.8. (19) We started in the **valley**(of despair,ch.1). We moved to the **watchtower** in ch.2. And here we end up on the **mountain top**.
- 3.5.9. God became Habakkuk's Strength, Song, & his Salvation!
- 3.5.10. If my legs were shaking, I probably would be looking for a place to sit down...not bounding up the side of a mountain, like a deer!
 - 3.5.10.1. The Lord gives us "bounding feet" so we can overcome the obstacles of life.
 - 3.5.10.2. God doesn't always change the circumstances, but He can change us to meet the circumstances!
 - 3.5.10.3. Faith gives you the ability to stand sure-footed like a deer,& to be able to run-swiftly & go higher then ever before!
- 3.5.11. Like the eagle & like the deer, God made us for the heights!
 3.5.11.1. They both will go down into the valley but that's not where they live! (us too!)

3.6. **Communion:**

- 3.6.1. A thought to ponder: "God doesn't reveal Himself to superficial saints who are only looking for a new experience they can brag about, or to curious Christians who want to sample deeper fellowship w/God but not at too great a price." (www)
 - 3.6.1.1. Is.66:2 "But on this one will I look: On him who is **poor** and of a **contrite spirit**, And who **trembles** at My word."
